The business has introduced a variety of leading employee policies over the course of the last 22 years, recently including those around co-parenting, menopause and fertility treatment.

Chris Silcock, managing director Kellanova, said: "Our Summer Hours programme is a great benefit for our teams, so they can take some extra time on a Friday to wind down for the weekend. Everyone works hard during the week so it's great to be able to give people half a day for themselves, particularly during the summer months. It also means we come back together reenergised and focused for the week ahead."

Amy Davies, senior customer service associate, Kellanova, said: "I've been working here for 35 years now, so was around when the Summer Hours programme was first introduced – and it's been a real game changer. Outside of work I love going for walks, especially with my dogs. Having the option to take a Friday afternoon off during summer gives me the time to explore new places and do what I love, which means I'm energised for the new week."

This year's Summer Hours will run from Friday 2 May 2025 to Friday 26 September 2025.
